We will start the term by comparing and expressing opinions about winter poems and writing our own.

After half term we will research the Winter Olympics creating fact files about the different sports and the history of the games.

Computing

Computing will include learning about internet safety and designing a computer game.

Religious Education

In RE we will be looking at what makes Jesus an inspiration to some people and the Easter Story

Theme

Our theme this term is Winter

Wonderland which will include:

Science—Changing state, properties of materials and lifecycles.

Geography—Changing seasons, places in the world, which parts are frozen and climate change and its effects.

History—The History of the Titanic.

DT—making igloo structures.

Art—Using different mediums, such as pastel, to create Winter pictures

In the 2nd half of the half term we will also look at the Winter Olympics, what sports are included, where they are being held and the history of the games.
