Autumn 2020: Superheroes!



Maths

The children will be given opportunities to apply their learning to “real life” maths problems using their calculation and problem-solving strategies.

We will be learning about the value of numbers and digits. We will be adding and subtracting numbers and using a range of strategies to solve problems.



English

We will be working hard to make sure all our letters are formed correctly and our handwriting is neat. We will be writing labels, captions, comic strips and superhero reports.

We will look at the stories, “Supertato”, “Charlie’s Missing Underpants”

We will also be learning a traditional story and writing our own version.



Science

In Science, the children will be identifying and naming a range of materials and investigating their properties and uses.

We will carry out a range of ‘Superhero’ science investigations.

We will be learning about the body and which part of the body is associated with each sense.



History

The children will learn about the lives and achievements of local hero William Wilberforce and American activist Rosa Parks.

They will compare their impact on the lives of others then and now.

Superheroes!



Art/DT

The children will be creating self-portraits and learning about colour mixing and shading.

We will be creating superhero portraits too.

In DT we will be making our own superhero vehicles and Christmas decorations.



PE

The children will be learning how to control their bodies to move in different ways. They will learn how to travel around the space safely and how to use different parts of the body to move in different ways.

They will also be learning how to do a range of jumps.



Music

The children will be learning about the different sounds we can hear and make using our voices and instruments. We will be using sounds expressively.

We will also be learning about pitch and tempo and creating our own superhero theme tunes!



Computing

Children will be using different multimedia to create pictures and images.

They will then learn how to programme sprites and learn how to make them move, change colour, shape and size.



RE

In RE we will be learning about sacred books and what Christians believe God is like We will be looking into why certain people like Jesus and Guru Nanak are important to those of particular religion.



Homework

Each week the children will receive spellings to learn and are expected to read to an adult up to 5 times a week



PSHE

This term in PSHE we will be learning about belonging and how we belong to our class and school. We will be recognising emotions and learning how to be good friends.
